*Program***

We look forward to being back in California for the two and a half-day National Coastal Conference. This year’s theme, “Shifting Shores, Surf and Sediment” was chosen to highlight the interplay between physical processes and the different types of shorelines located within the coastal zone. We will also be holding a pre-conference workshop on our Coastal Sediment Regulations Project that is being conducted in partnership with Coastal States Organization, and two short courses in partnership with the Coastal Zone Foundation.

Two, Half-day Short Courses: The CZF Short Courses will be held on Tuesday, September 13th from 8 a.m. until 12 p.m. and 1 p.m. until 5 p.m. with the topics of Common Mistakes in Design of Coastal & Marine and Engineering with Nature[®], respectively.

These basic courses are intended for coastal practitioners, professionals, consultants and representatives from government agencies and nongovernmental organizations. Students and new professionals are also encouraged to attend. The short course topic is one module that will be offered in partial completion of the Certified Coastal Practitioner (CCP) program. The complete program will consist of 10 or more modules offering a broad,

multidisciplinary platform of knowledge for current and prospective coastal professionals and providing an introductory look at the various areas of coastal expertise that are crucial to successful and sound coastal management. The basic objective of this program is to deliver the fundamentals of each topic applied in coastal management, so that individuals obtain exposure to a breadth of knowledge and expertise.
